Aim

Objectives

- explain factors influencing land and water management and their consequences
- identify synergy and conflict, promoters and barriers
- produce data bases and appraisal methods to support decision making
- identify risks and uncertainties



Approach (1)

- historical analysis of the dynamics of change on a selection of 22
 Agricultural Flood
 Defence Schemes implemented during period 1960-1980 and previously studied during the 1980s.
- 40 year historical perspective in order to look forward
- building on integration





Approach (2)

- DPSIR framework: institutional analysis and stakeholder mapping
- farmer behaviour
- farming systems
- biodiversity conservation
- flooding and water level regimes
- achieving integration: scenario analysis




Outcomes
